1. Trip Permission Form (separate form)

This event is sponsored by the Georgia Music Educators Association (GMEA). Parents are welcome to attend our performance. In addition, students must achieve satisfactory sight-reading & repertoire progress to be permitted to participate. (Tested classes include Algebra I, Biology, US History (non-AP), 11th Grade Am. Lit & Comp classes only during 5th period) We depart for LGPE promptly at 10:10am, and perform at 11:20am. We will return around 12:25pm. You will then eat lunch during 6th period lunch and go to your 7th period class like normal.

On March 7, 2023, BHS Cantabile (4th periods) will perform at LGPE. Meet in the chorus room, **dressed in concert attire**, at **2:20pm** for warm-up. We depart for LGPE promptly at 2:50pm and perform at 4:40pm. We will return around 5:40pm. **You will need a ride home that evening**.
