

Uniform Ordering Information

2023-2024

Please read **BEFORE** ordering:

- **ALL orders** will be placed online. <u>Click here to order</u> the deadline is August 24, 2023.
- Students must get measured I will offer this in class (dependent on volunteer help), but it is ultimately up to each student/family. Take your measurements to determine what size items to order.
- Students are required to select one of three uniform options below.
- Students new to 3rd or 4th period chorus this year will need to order the appropriate color sash (option 2) or cummerbund/bow tie (option 3).
- Formal Attire is to be worn for all concert performances except the spring show. The spring show uniform, for all singers, is the 2023-2024 Brookwood Chorus T-Shirt, blue jeans (no rips/holes), and tennis shoes/sneakers.
- If you have your concert attire from prior years **and it still fits comfortably**, you may wear it. 9th Grade Basses/Tenors may need to augment their older uniform with our vest & tie. If you had formal attire from middle school, it is probably best to order a new uniform at this point in time. However, it still fits, bring it in to show me in class and we can talk!
- ***All students in 5th period chorus should purchase option 2 (white tux shirt, pants, vest, tie). Students in 2nd, 3rd, or 4th period chorus classes should select option 1 (black dress) or option 3 (black tux/pants, cummerbund & bow tie).

OPTION 1

Traditionally worn by sopranos & altos.

- Long Black Concert Dress: (Dresses will be available to check sizing in class)
- Sash (for 3rd & 4th Periods ONLY)
 - 3rd Period: Burgundy
 - \circ 4th Period: Gold
- There will be a size run of dresses for folks to try on in class to make sure of size. You will be responsible for hemming the dress to appropriate length (just touching foot).
- YOU PROVIDE SHOES: Flat-heeled Black Dress Shoes with Enclosed Toe -please consider simple flat ballerina type shoes as you will need to be comfortable and we will be climbing steps from time to time (NO PLATFORMS, BOOTS, OR TENNIS SHOES Flip Flops or Sandals do NOT have an enclosed toe)
- Flesh, suntan, or light black hose (if you wear any).
- No jewelry should be visible to the audience from the stage.

Traditionally worn by tenors & basses.

Tuxedo Attire (no jacket)

<u>Full Ensemble</u> (if buying all pieces):

- Black Vest
- White pleated tux shirt with lay down collar
- Black Adjustable Waist Tux Pants (unhemmed-you will have to take care of this)
- Maroon Pre-knotted Windsor Long Necktie

Find these items on your own:

- Black Dress Shoes (tennis shoes, flip flops, sandals, and boots are not dress shoes)
- Black Dress Socks

OPTION 3

- Black Adjustable Waist Tux Pants (unhemmed-you will have to take care of this)
- Black Pleated Tuxedo Shirt (regular dress lay down collar male cut shirt)
- Cummerbund & Bow Tie (Color dependent on class)
 - 2nd Period: Black
 - \circ 3rd Period: Maroon
 - $\circ \quad 4^{th} \text{ Period: Gold}$
 - o 5th Period: Maroon
